- **1. Call to Order-** Tom Kozlowski, President, called the meeting to order at 8:39am.

The Board thought it may be of member interest so will recommend that there be a demo for the SAR Board at their April meeting. The SAR Board should consider negotiating a rate for brokers to sign up for themselves.

B. New Product Update

The MLS Director gave an update on the product roll outs for Matrix 360, MLS touch, Box MLS, and Trestle. Matrix 360 implementation has been postponed due to mapping issues and holes in the product. MLS Touch is projected to launch April 29th but has had a few setbacks. Programmers are not sure that they can redirect clients and brokers to the app. It is possible that we may need to run parallel so that brokers have time to re-invite their clients into the new system. The MLS Director is looking at easier solutions. BoxMLS was kickstarted March 6th. Launch Date is expected to be about May 6-7th. The Board chose themountainmls.com as the url and chose to use the current SAR logo for the product. The MLS Director is also looking to get Realist and ShowingTime integrated before the launch.

C. County Assessor Membership

The MLS Board was tasked with creating a fee structure for County Assessor's offices. The current fees were reviewed. The Board agreed that licensed Assessors will be assessed the same fees as non-member licensees, which includes an annual fee of \$685, and the monthly \$50 MLS fee. Other, unlicensed staff will need to sign limited license agreements. The SAR Board will determine the membership level at the April Board meeting.

9. New Business

A. Clareity Workshop updates

The MLS Director provided an update on the Clareity workshop in Scottsdale at the end of February. The conference was attended by Tom Kozlowski, Isabel Rawson, Chantal Wener, and Kristi Gifford. Key topics included Upstream chose Corelogic as their vendor, Photo enhancements and if virtual staging is ok, a legal update, coming soon listings, RESO is now pushing for MLS to mandate that vendors be RESO certified as well. While it was not discussed at the Clareity conference, the Moerhl vs. NAR Lawsuit was discussed at the Board meeting.
